Parents Evening – Tuesday 19th and Wednesday 20th March 2024

Due to safeguarding and health and safety concerns it is not possible for children to be on the school site during this time. Please note that only *one appointment is available per child* at each parent/carer & teacher consultation. We recognise that some children have parents that are separated. Where separated parents both wish to attend the parent/teacher consultation, we expect that, unless restricted by the court, they jointly attend the same Parent/Teacher Consultation appointment in the ethos of positive co-parenting.

Tuesday 19th March

Wednesday 20th March

Years R to 6 Parents' Evening between 4.40pm – 6.20pm

All parent/teacher consultations will take place in the School Hall and children's books will be available for you to look at in the library area. Please take a seat in the hall a few minutes before your appointment so that the teacher knows you are here. The end of your allocated 10 minute appointment will be signified by the ringing of a bell. If you feel that you need more time to talk with your child's teacher an additional appointment can be made at a later date.

An invitation to book your appointment will be sent to you on Monday 4th March.

Please note that the Mental Health Support Team will also be available to speak to on Tuesday 19th March in the library should you have any questions or need help with support.
