Sapphire Class Trip to The British Museum – Wednesday 26th June 2024

On Wednesday 26th June Sapphire Class will be going on an exciting trip to The British Museum as part of our summer term project- Walk Like an Egyptian, where we will be learning all about what life was like in Ancient Egypt. The class will have the chance to see one of the best collections of Ancient Egyptian artefacts in the UK, including The Rosetta Stone and a large collection of Egyptian mummies.

We will also have the chance to study artefacts used in Roman Britain, linked to our past spring project- The Road from Rome.

We will travel by coach leaving school at 9.00am. We will return to school in time for collection at 3.20pm.
