Infant Trip to Hinton Ampner – Wednesday 15th April 2026

On Wednesday 15th April, the Infants will be going on an exciting trip as the hook for our Summer projects. We will be visiting Hinton Ampner to explore the gardens and look at the different types of plants and mini-beast habitats. We will travel by coach leaving school at 9.15am. We will return to school in time for collection at 3.20pm.

The voluntary contribution for this trip is £12.00, which you can pay online via your Scopay account. However, if the activity cannot be funded by voluntary contributions then it may have to be cancelled. **We ask for your voluntary contribution by Friday 23th March.**

The children will need to wear their school uniform including, school jumper or cardigan and their own comfortable trousers or leggings (these can be their PE joggers). They will also need comfortable trainers, no wellies please. School packed lunches are available to order. Please log onto your child's Scopay account to specify if your child would like a ham/cheese/tuna half baguette. **Please note the deadline for ordering a school packed lunch is 9am on Monday 23rd March.** All other snacks will be provided for the children and water bottles can be refilled. If the weather forecast looks sunny, please apply sun cream to your child before they come to school on the day and provide a sun hat.

Volunteers are required for this trip and all volunteers will need to go through relevant compliance checks including a DBS check. If you would like to volunteer for this, or any other trips in the future, please contact Mrs Jones (via the school office), who will meet with you to discuss this process.
