Junior Disco (Y3 - Y6) - 6:15pm-7:15pm - £3.00

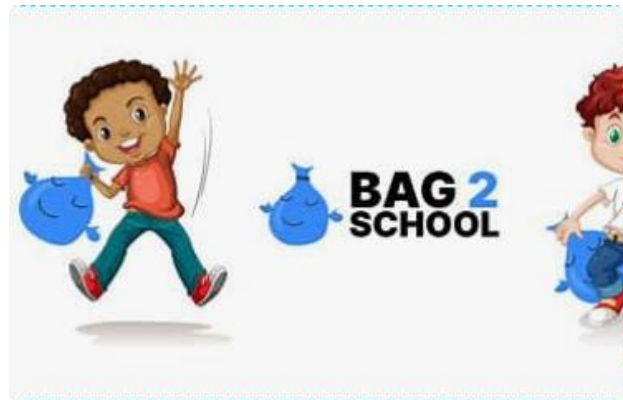
