



PRINCIPLES FOR HOME LEARNING

- The programme of home learning supports and extends learning in class.
- Parents are encouraged to become involved in their child's learning in a meaningful way.
- Children's interest, enjoyment and motivation in their work is fostered through a range of home learning experiences.
- Good work habits are established to sustain future learning and increase children's independence in their learning.
- Home learning is designed to provide support and challenge according to individual needs.
- Skills are practiced and confidence increased in a variety of subject areas and in new and different contexts.
- Home learning outcomes are shared within the class and to a wider audience.
- From time to time, opportunities are provided for children to follow own lines of enquiry based upon their interests and undertake research using resources available beyond the school.
- Parents maintain a clear view of children's progress in the areas covered by home learning.
- Partnerships with parents are developed which encourage quality time with children and give further insight into the school curriculum.
