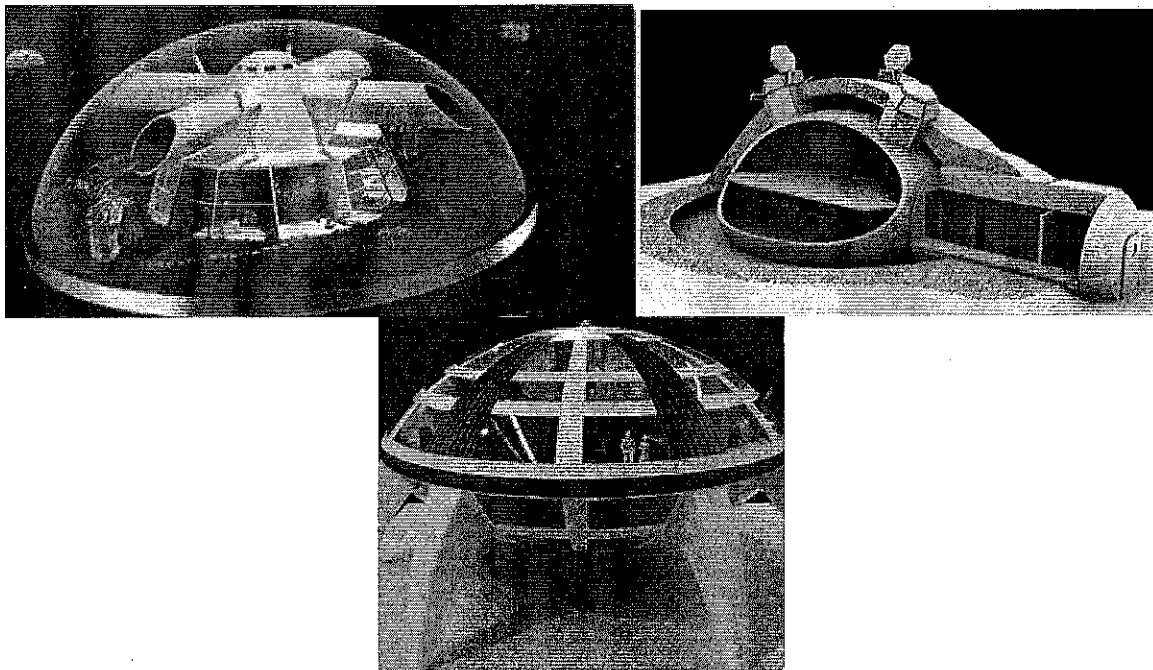


Houston
